Not long after penning the above, travellers decided to pitch camp on Peartree Playing Field on the sunny afternoon of 15th April. As this field is a local authority amenity site the police were able to escort them out of Brentwood about 3½ hours after their arrival. The Parish Council would like to extend their thanks to all who helped resolve the matter quickly and with minimum fuss. This includes our Borough Councillors, Brentwood Council enforcement officers and the Police. We are also extremely grateful to the vigilant villagers of Doddinghurst as many people telephoned the authorities as soon as they became aware of what was happening.

## Dog Fouling

Unfortunately we have once again been receiving complaints about people leaving doggy bags (and I don't mean the food kind!) in bushes and hedgerows around the village rather than taking them home or using the bins specifically provided for disposal. A particular hot spot for this type of unsavoury activity is the un-adopted section of Peartree Lane at the end of Lime Grove. We ask all dog owners using this area to have consideration for the nearby residents as we are sure nobody would want this sort of decoration around their own property! If the culprit(s) can be identified they will be reported to the police as this is a criminal offence under the Litter Act 1996 which carries a hefty fine.

## Update on Village Hall and Priest House refurbishment

The Parish Council is pleased to report that all the £100,000 provided in Grant money has been spent on these buildings and enabled the refurbishment work to be completed.

### **Dogs around Children's Play Area**

Now that the summer is almost upon us can we remind dog walkers to be aware that the amount of children in and around the play area increases significantly particularly after school and at weekends. If dogs are off the lead where the children play then they can be tempted to join in the fun and this can be quite distressing for a small child faced with a big dog intent on jumping up at them.
